## HCACR OPEN DAY. PARKING INFORMATION

- APSLEY. Sainsburys car park opposite church. Toilets, refreshments and petrol.
- H. HEMPSTEAD. The High Street is one-way from Queensway. Some limited free parking on the street, but check signs carefully as it changes along the street! P&D car park recommended. Where the one way section ends, the car park entrance is on the left, off a mini roundabout. Turn left and drive to far end of car park. Churchyard is in front of you. Tower door outside on far side of church. Toilet in hall.
- BERKHAMSTED. Some half hour spaces on street. Mostly free on side streets, but spaces limited. Suggest you use the Tesco car park (P&D). West of the church same side. Toilets next door – ask stewards.
- NORTHCHURCH. Use school car park behind church. Entrance on New Road. Turn in to school and follow drive to rear of school. Gate into churchyard in far right corner. Toilets in hall.
- TRING. Free car park by church. Entrance on Frogmore Street. Free for one hour, but you must display a ticket.
- PUTTENHAM. Park by church.
- ALDBURY. Park in roads around church. Toilet in church.
- LT. GADDESSEN. Please use car park. You can park outside the church but please be aware that large farm machines use the road! Toilet in church.
- GT. GADDESSEN. Limited spaces on Church Meadow. Or park on main road between church and garden centre. Or use garden centre! Please do not park in the gravelled area between private houses. This is private parking. Tower door is outside at rear of church. Toilet is on your right, external access.
- FLAMSTEAD. Park on roads around church.
- HARPENDEN. All on road parking is free on Saturdays. If no spaces available off Church Green, try Rothamsted Avenue/Salisbury Avenue/Kirkwick Avenue. There is a footpath from the bottom of Kirkwick into the churchyard. Toilet in hall.
- RADLETT. Large car park at church. Toilet in church.
- ALDENHAM. Park in layby outside church, or on road. Toilet in hall.
- ELSTREE. Hopefully parking in St Nicholas School, at the end of St Nicholas Close. **TBC**.
- BUSHEY HEATH. Use car park opposite church on High Road.

- BUSHEY. Please use free car park in Kemp Place (up hill from church, same side). Toilet in hall.
- RICKMANSWORTH. Free car park at rear of church. Pass the church on Church Street, turn left into Bury Lane, and take first left into car park. Path at far end of car park into churchyard. Toilet in hall
- SARRATT. Please use small car park by the church. If this is full, please park on the road ON THE SAME SIDE AS THE CHURCH. There is a very grumpy man in one of the cottages who thinks he owns the road.... Toilet in car park.
- LANGLEYBURY. Some spaces in churchyard, or use layby by traffic lights.
- AB. LANGLEY. Church car park at rear. Toilet in hall.
- K. LANGLEY. Park on Church Lane, or in Great Park (opposite side of main road from church). Toilet in church.
- REDBOURN. A few spaces in churchyard, or park on the road by the church. Toilet in church.
